

Ottawa Valley Pistol League Clubs and Range Directions

This season, the following ranges will be used for League matches and other events, indoors and outdoors.

Indoor Ranges

Arnprior District Rifle & Revolver Club (Arnprior)

Six positions, 20 yards, turning targets.

To get to the club, take the White Lake Road exit to the right (into Arnprior) and go down to the second set of lights, at Baskin Drive.

Turn left and follow Baskin Drive to a big sweeping curve to the right. This curve is actually where Baskin becomes Division Street.

About halfway around the curve, you will see the Division Street on your left, where it goes to the clubhouse. Turn left on Division St. and follow it to the ramp that goes over 417. The road to the clubhouse is on the left (no. 474), part way up the ramp.

RA Gun Club, Ottawa (RAGC)

Fourteen positions, 20 yards, turning targets, spotting scopes provided.

Directions: 2451 Riverside Drive
(in the RA Centre complex)

Bronson Avenue, south to Riverside Drive;
Property is the first entrance (right) after passing under the bridge;
Access to the range is via the stairs at the curling rink, in the middle of the building.

Outdoor Ranges

Eastern Ontario Shooting Club (EOSC)

Multiple outdoor ranges to 50 metres - situated in Larose Forest, east of Ottawa.

Directions: Hwy 417 east (towards Montreal) to Exit #88 (Vars/Embrun);
North through Vars and turn right (east) on Russell Road;
At about 10.5 km, reach a traffic signal at the crossroads in the village of Cheney.
Turn right on Drouin Road and drive 2.4 km straight south into Larose Forest.
The (new) entrance is on the right-hand side soon after the pavement ends.

National Capital Region Rifle Association (NCRRA)

Connaught Ranges - Ottawa

Multiple outdoor ranges - host to the Victoria Day shoots.

Directions: From Hwy. 417 (Exit 134), drive north on Moodie Drive 1.7 km. to Hwy 17B;
Left (west) from Moodie Drive to Range Road 2.6 km;
Turn right (north) on Range Road 2 km to Shirley's Bay;
Left (west) on Malibar to Lee Enfield. Right to Shirley Blvd.
Right to outdoor pistol ranges.

Other Clubs

Smiths Falls District Handgun Club (SFHG)

Host for silhouette shoots.

They have a sturdy covered firing line, with a variety of distances available from it. An old bus serves as shelter, clubhouse and café.

Directions: 322 Hwy 15 south of Smiths Falls
South of Smiths Falls on Hwy 15
Number 322 - located on west side of Highway. Entrance gate at Parson's Welding -
watch for orange farm-vehicle markers.

When approaching from Smiths Falls, you'll pass the Kingdom Hall at the junction with Poonamalie Rd. The entrance is just a few doors farther along the highway

Smiths Falls Fish and Game Club (SFFG)

Multiple outdoor ranges for pistol, rifle and shotgun.

Directions: 354 Hwy 15 south of Smiths Falls
South of Smiths Falls on Hwy 15
Number 354 - located on west side of Highway

South of Smiths Falls on Hwy 15.

The club property is number 354, on the west side of the highway, less than 1 KM south of the Poonamalie Road.
