Welcome!

Hello and welcome to the Ottawa Valley Pistol League. We shoot a series of matches, but each match is between just two teams at a time.

Shooting in the League is open to those who are invited by their OVPL team. New shooters get a taste of competition without the travel expense. Established competitors have the opportunity to test themselves throughout the winter.

Format and Fees

The matches are *team matches*. A shooter cannot hurt his or her team by scoring 'poorly'. Since only the best scores count for the team score, only 'good' scores will affect a team's chances at a match. We collect a nominal fee that pays for our awards at the end of the season. Juniors shoot free. For everyone's first match, the fee is waived.

Course of Fire

Each match is 60 shots: half .22 and half with centre-fire (.32, .38 or 9mm). There is an option of shooting the whole match with just the .22. Most of the shooting is based upon these events:

ISSF Standard Pistol. and
ISSF Centre-Fire.

We use uses two kinds of targets: the Precision target and the Rapid Fire (all black) version. Both are round and bullseye-like. Except for the RF target, the time limit is different for each of the six targets (60 shots). Don't worry - that's all explained before each target is fired.
